Placement Info 2021-2022

Use the Information below as a guide to help you select your class level. Your dance level may need to be adjusted based on actual class enrollment levels as well as teacher recommendations.

Ballet and Pointe

If you were in Ballet 4 Core last season, you are now in Ballet 5 Core.

Ballet 3b and Pre-pointe are now in Ballet 4 Core and Pointe 1.

Ballet 3 will be placed in Ballet 3a, 3b or Ballet 4, by teacher recommendation.

Miss Katie H.'s Ballet 2/3 students from 2020/2021 should enroll in Ballet 2b or 2/3

Miss Rebecca's Ballet 2/3 students should sign up for Ballet 2c/3 and Ballet 3a.

Please speak to Miss Rebecca for individual placement questions.

Miss Gina's Ballet 2a sign up for Ballet 2, 2b, 2/3 by her recommendation.

Pointe 3 students stay the same.

Pointe 2 students stay the same.

Pre-pointe dancers are now Pointe 1. Congratulations!

Pre-pointe recommendations will be made by Ballet teachers.

All Core Level 3 and up Ballet classes must take at least two Core Ballet Classes per week. This does not include a pointe class as one of the two classes.

Jazz, Hip Hop and Street

Jazz 1 is now Jazz 2

Jazz 2 is now Jazz 3

Jazz 3a is now Jazz 4a

Jazz 3b is now Jazz 4B

Jazz 4 is now Jazz 5

Jazz 5 is still Jazz 5

All Jazz 3 and higher classes must include at least one ballet class.

Hip Hop Levels 1, 2 & 3 will stay the same next year.

Street Dance: There is just one level.

Modern

Modern 5 is still Modern 5 (grades 9-12)

Modern 4/5 take Modern 4 (gr. 7-10) or Modern 5. See Miss Rebecca if unsure.

Modern 3b take Modern 3b or Modern 4. Miss Rebecca's recommendation.

Modern 3a take Modern 3b. (Grades 6-8)

Modern/Tumble 2b take Modern/Tumble 2/3 (gr.4-5) (ballet encouraged)

Modern/Tumble/Ballet should take Ballet 2 and Modern 2 (We will include tumbling.) Modern 2 (gr. 2-4)

Modern/tumble 1- grades 1-3

All Modern 3 and higher classes must include at least one ballet class.

Contemporary

Contemporary 4/5 with Miss Katie C. Is now Contemporary 5.

New to Contemporary: See Miss Shannon for her recommendation.

Teen Contemporary can sign up for a level 4 Contemporary class.

Contemporary 3a/3b with Miss Shannon is for students age 10+. Grades 5-7

Contemporary 4 with Miss Katie C. is for Grades 7+

Contemporary 4/5 with Miss Shannon age 13+ Grades 8+

Tap

Tap 3/4 is now called Advanced Tap

Jazz/tap and Ballet/Tap students interested in continuing should take Tap 1/2. Beginner Tap is for students in grades 6-12 that want to learn to Tap.

Choreography

Choreo/Acro 1 is for grades 4-6. See Miss Rebecca for placement.

Acro/Choreography 2 is for grades 6 and up. You must be able to do a cartwheel, a bridge from the floor and a handstand against the wall.

Acro/Aerial/Choreography 3- for dancers that were in Choreo 2/3 last year. You must be able to do a one handed cartwheel and be open to learning front walk-overs. Class includes: Aerial silks and possibly wrist grips; Partnering will be included once allowed by CDC; Solos as well as small group pieces in the Choreography section of class. Grades 7+
